Granada Film Office: Services

Granada Film Office is a public service of the City Council whose mission is to promote the city as a filming location for audiovisual productions, to assist companies and professionals who choose Granada to carry out their projects, supporting the local audiovisual sector and stimulating investment and local development.

This office operates as a one-stop shop for producers, ensuring the success and efficiency of every project, from pre-production to post-production. We provide guidance on permits and accompany you throughout the development of your project in the city of Granada.

Location assistance and personalised guidance.

- Location database: Access to a wide selection of locations and advice from local professionals. Consulting services and assistance with location scouting, planning and shooting logistics.
- Practical information: Information on local regulations, image rights and use of public spaces.

Technical and organisational assistance.


- Permit management: This office can mediate to speed up administrative processes in order to obtain filming permits for public and heritage spaces with maximum efficiency.
- Coordination with all municipal services and local institutions: Direct contact with key municipal departments: police, fire services, municipal infrastructure to coordinate traffic control, changes in furniture and lighting.

Logistics and coordination

- Local infrastructure: Connects filmmakers with local suppliers of filming equipment, machinery rentals, transportation and support staff, from catering to security and more.
- Production coordination: Granada Film Office collaborates with local production companies, offering coordination and logistical support at every stage of the project.
- Accommodation and transportation: Assistance in finding accommodation and transportation for the technical and artistic team, including private transportation services and transfer coordination.

Why Granada?

Granada not only is a place of beauty and diversity but also a space filled with opportunities for creativity and audiovisual production. Its ability to offer **historical, modern, and natural settings** within the same environment, combined with its favourable climate, accessibility, and institutional support, makes the city a top-tier destination for filmmakers.

One of Granada's greatest advantages, and what makes it **unique**, is the proximity between its historical and contemporary settings. It's possible to shoot a scene in a 13th-century palace and, within minutes, move to a 21st-century modern building. The city itself offers **unmatched contrast and versatility**, allowing for the recreation of various eras and environments in one single location.

Granada not only boasts stunning architecture, but also a varied geography. Among many of the options, we have the Sierra Nevada mountains 30 km away, which offer alpine landscapes with snow during most of the year. Additionally, the Gorafe desert and the Costa Tropical 70 km from Granada, provide Mediterranean coastal scenery allowing the recreation of diverse environments.



Granada offers locations with great narrative potential, experienced professionals, production services, favourable climate, competitive costs, authenticity and cultural variety. To boost your project, we can also help you with connections and accessibility, infrastructure and logistical and institutional support.



With over 300 days of sunshine per year, Granada guarantees favourable weather conditions for outdoor filming most of the year. Its Mediterranean climate offers mild winters and long summers, allowing for smooth shoots without unexpected weather interruptions.





Diversity of landscapes in close proximity:

In a single day, it is possible to shoot scenes in snow-capped mountains, desert areas, beaches, and historical monuments.

The city is an icon of the cultural fusion of East and West.

Vibrant and modern city:

The city boasts a unique mix of Moorish, Renaissance and modern architecture, making Granada an adaptable setting for a wide variety of cinematic periods and styles.



Infrastructure and logistical support:

Granada has a growing film industry and production services, including facilities to accommodate film crews.



Competitive costs:

Granada is a more economical option compared to other major European cities while maintaining high quality standards.



Tax incentives:

Filming in Granada can be highly advantageous from an economic perspective thanks to Spain's tax incentives. International productions can benefit from tax breaks of up to 40% on expenses incurred during filming, making Granada a competitive and attractive option from a financial standpoint.



Local incentives:

In terms of local incentives, in addition to the services of this office, which are free of charge, Granada's City Council offers exemption from filming fees for all noncommercial productions (commercial productions pay a minimal daily fee). Free services such as parking, traffic control, furniture and lighting adjustments may also be provided for all productions.





Proximity and Connectivity:

Granada is well-connected by road, rail and air. Through Federico García Lorca airport, the city has direct flights to several European cities. In addition, Granada's proximity to international airports enhances global connections. The city also has a modern transport network, which facilitates local and regional travel.

Facilities and buildings:

Privately owned, they can facilitate pre-production,

with spaces equipped with offices, warehouses, easy

parking for vehicles with material and just 10 minutes

from the city center.




Hotels:

Granada is the Andalusian capital with the largest number of hotel accommodations. It offers around 15,000 beds and 400 hotel establishments, with a wide variety and quality of catering services. Granada Film Office provides assistance with coordination through the Hospitality association and negotiation of prices.



Professionals:

Granada offers a wide range of professional services of proven experience and quality, such as bilingual professionals. Similarly, there are local businesses that hire equipment (camera, grip, lighting, props, costumes, etc.) They work in collaboration with companies in Granada, and by being in the city, they reduce costs and minimise time. Granada Film Office works closely with the Association of Audiovisual Technicians of Granada (ATECA). You will be able to contact highly qualified professionals with experience in large national and international productions as well as with companies that cover all areas of the production process.
